Rules & Ordinances:

Approval of Rules & Ordinance Committee Minutes of July 12, 2021

Old Business:

Resolution #21-07: Entering into an agreement with Jones & Henry Engineers A motion was made by Frank, seconded by Johnson to authorize the Village Administrator to enter into an agreement with Jones & Henry Engineers for service to design sanitary sewer service for areas along Co. Rd. H near State Route 109 on its 3rd reading. All votes yea, motion carried.

Resolution #21-09: Entering into an agreement with State of OH, DNR A motion was made by Dawson, seconded by Tanner to authorize the Village Administrator to enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Natural Resources for cooperative fishing agreement on its 2nd reading. All votes yea, motion carried.

Resolution #21-10: To renew an existing levy for the police department A motion was made by Dawson, seconded by Todd to declare it necessary to renew an existing levy for the police department pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code sections 5705.19(H) and 5705.25 and requesting the auditor to certify the amount of revenue to be generated by the proposed levy renewal on its 2nd reading. A motion was made by Frank seconded by Todd to supplement Ordinance #2030 to make supplemental appropriations for the current expenses of the Village of Delta for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2021, on its 2nd reading. All votes yea, motion carried.

Resolution #21-11: Entering into an agreement with DGL Consulting Engineers A motion was made by Tanner, seconded by Johnson to authorize the Village Administrator to enter into an agreement with DGL Consulting Engineers to survey and design a downtown entrance feature on West Main Street on its 1st reading. All votes yea, motion carried.
