Approval of Minutes: Council December 20, 2021

A motion was made by Lynn Frank, seconded by Ashley Todd to approve the December 20, 2021, council minutes as written. All votes yea, motion carried.

Nomination and election of Council President:

Chad Johnson nominated Mike Tanner as Council President. Lynn Frank nominated Mike Tanner as Council President. There were no other nominations. Mike Tanner accepted the position.

Village Administrator:

A motion was made by Tanner, seconded by Todd to authorize the Village Administrator to advertise for bids and enter a contract for the construction of the Fulton County water connection on its 1st reading. All votes yea, motion carried.

Mr. Peebles explained we received the grant in the amount of \$1,038,000 and are trying to bid early so we may receive a better price.

Resolution #22-02: To advertise for bids on construction of roadway w/utilities

A motion was made by Tanner, seconded by Todd to authorize the Village Administrator to bid and enter a contract for the construction of roadway with utilities to support the expansion of Nature Fresh Farms distribution complex on its 1st reading. All votes yea, motion carried. A motion was made by Frank, seconded by Tanner to move the next regular council meeting to the 24th of January. All votes yea, motion carried.
