Approval of Minutes: Council March 21, 2022

A motion was made by Lynn Frank, seconded by Ashley Todd to approve the March 21, 2022, council minutes as written. All votes yea, motion carried.

Public addressing council:

Kyle Comers, 608 Fernwood Street, had questions concerning Resolution 22-06 and the agreement with Bunting Bearings, Inc and Fulton County Land Bank. Mr. Peebles explained the situation concerning the grant monies and Village funds associated with Bunting Bearings Inc. property.

John Bay requested to discuss Ordinance 22-02 and the park portion of the legislation. He would like to see oak trees to be planted in the park rather than transfer money from the Park Fund to the General Fund.

Ms. Mossing explained that the Park wasn't transferring money to the General Fund, but rather appropriating more funds into the Park Fund. Mr. Bay misunderstood the legislation.
