

ORDINANCE NO 04-2025

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A
PATROL VEHICLE FOR THE DELTA POLICE
DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Delta Police Department is in need of purchasing a new patrol vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the budget approved by Council for fiscal year 2025 includes an amount to allow for the purchase of a new police vehicle; and

WHEREAS, due to market conditions, the availability of police vehicles has become more limited; and

WHEREAS, Terry Hendricks Chrysler Dodge Jeep Ram has a vehicle that can be outfitted as a police vehicle for the Village of Delta Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Delta, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. The Village Administrator is authorized to purchase a police vehicle from Terry Hendricks Chrysler Dodge Jeep Ram for the total sum not to exceed Forty Two Thousand, Nine Hundred and Thirty One Dollars (\$42,931.00), along with associated uplifting from Raylecom of Seventeen Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty Four Dollars and twelve cents (\$17,884.12) , for a total cost of Sixty Thousand, Eight Hundred Fifteen Dollars and twelve cents (\$60,815.12).

Section 2. Council hereby finds it is in the best interests of the Village to dispense with competitive bidding and therefore approves this purchase without competitive bidding.

Section 3. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this ordinance, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meeting open to the public as required by law.

Section 4. This ordinance is deemed an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide the Police Department with proper and approved equipment.

This ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date allowed by law.
